

Adjunct Professor J.V. D’Cruz

Adjunct Professor J.V. D’Cruz joined the Institute and the Centre, having returned in 2001 from a four-year research and teaching appointment at the National University of Malaysia. He is a partner in the Institute for the Study of Human Services. Professor D’Cruz previously taught for 20 years at La Trobe University, where he had variously been Chair of the Centre for International and Comparative Education and the Centre for the Study of Innovation in Education. He began his university career part-time and simultaneously at Monash in the Faculty of Education in 1971 and at Melbourne University in the Department of Political Science. He was a senior advisor to the Victorian Ministry of Education on a number of issues over the years, and is the author of two reports issued by the Ministry of Education—*The D’Cruz Report 1989 on Adult Basic Education* and *The D’Cruz Report 1990 on Technology in Education*. He was also a Victorian Government appointed Trustee on the Telematics Course Development Trust Fund between 1991 and 1999. He has been a visiting professor at universities in several South and South East Asian countries. Professor D’Cruz has published widely in a number of areas, with some 20 volumes to his credit. His most recent published work in 2001, published by Monash Asia Institute and Monash University Press is titled *Australia’s Ambivalence Towards Asia: Politics, Neo/Post-colonialism, and Fact/Fiction* (coauthored with William Steele), with a Foreword by Professor Ashis Nandy (Delhi) and an Afterword by Professor David Walker (Deakin).
